Description Imagine you're inside a VM with small window, you invoke settings screen like shown on screenshot and you try to press on SAVE button that's at the bottom. You can't. Someone on IRC suggested I could drag the window with win+drag and that worked, I was able to drag the window above the topbar, but what if I didn't know that, what if I tried dragging it with cursor and would be stuck at the top (cursor doesn't go beyond the screen)? Next issue is "Enable custom proposals" checkbox.
